# AUDITION CHEATSHEET

**SIX TIPS TO HELP YOU NAIL YOUR NEXT AUDITION**

## **1. ARRIVE EARLY.**

Be sure to arrive with plenty of time to park, sign in, and stretch.

## **2. PREPARE MATERIALS BEFOREHAND.**

Have 8x10 headshot ready with one-page resume stapled to back.

## **3. DRESS THE PART.**

Don't wear a costume, but dress nicely and in the style of the project for which the audition is casting.

## **4. FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS AND BE RESPECTFUL.**

The production team is likely looking at more than just how well you dance. Be sure to follow all given instructions, and be respectful to staff and other dancers.

## **5. THANK THE PRODUCTION TEAM.**

Before you leave, give the choreographer and production team a firm hand shake, remind them of your name, and thank them for the opportunity.

## **6. GET OUT OF YOUR HEAD, AND GET INTO YOUR GREATNESS!**

Be fully present in the moment, take a deep breath, and give it all you got.
