THE WORKING DANCER AUDITION CHEATSHEET

SIX TIPS TO HELP YOU NAIL YOUR NEXT AUDITION

1. ARRIVE EARLY.

Be sure to arrive with plenty of time to park, sign in, and stretch.

2. PREPARE MATERIALS BEFOREHAND.

Have 8x10 headshot ready with one-page resume stapled to back.

3. DRESS THE PART.

Don't wear a costume, but dress nicely and in the style of the project for which the audition is casting.

4. FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS AND BE RESPECTFUL.

The production team is likely looking at more than just how well you dance. Be sure to follow all given instructions, and be respectful to staff and other dancers.

5. THANK THE PRODUCTION TEAM.

Before you leave, give the choreographer and production team a firm hand shake, remind them of your name, and thank them for the opportunity.

6. GET OUT OF YOUR HEAD, AND GET INTO YOUR GREATNESS!

Be fully present in the moment, take a deep breath, and give it all you got.

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
